As you already know this term's topic is 'Things that go'. The children have already had some great ideas about what we could be learning and we have lots of marble runs, transport, ramps, and a fire/police/ambulance station in the class. We are planning a visit to the Devon Steam Railway at Buckfastleigh.

It is great for the children to link learning to home and school so here are some suggestions of things you could do that might link in to our learning. Please send in all you do at home so we can celebrate and share learning at school.



Look for 'Things that go' whilst at home and out and about. Which things move in a park? How does it work? How does your bike work? Draw a picture of the things you find which move and label them.

Design and construct vehicles that go. Make a plan of it, make it, how could you make it better? Who is it for? Where do they go in it?

Design a marble run, a domino race.



Write a story about an adventure on a hot air balloon (or any mode of transport). Who is in the story? Where do they go? What happens there? How does it end?

In numeracy we are learning about time, money, addition and subtraction. Use these as much as you can in real life contexts. What is the time? How much is that altogether? If two more cars arrive at the garage how many altogether?
