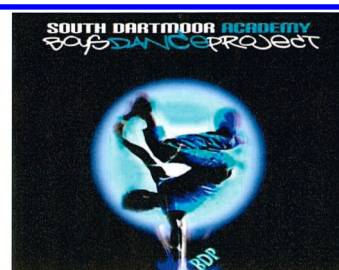
My Week by ... Eliza & Kedi
