Do some research on castles

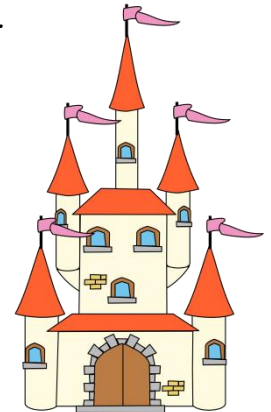
Visit a castle
