The children have worked and played hard this term. The progress they have made has been impressive, we are very proud of them. We are now all looking forward to the Easter holidays. Some parents have asked how they can support their child's learning at home over the two week break, so here are a few ideas to support your child's learning over the Easter holidays. You do not have to do them all!

- Reading regularly to and with your child. They could write a book review of a favourite book.
- Learning to read the high frequency words. Year 1 make sure you know phase 1, 2, 3, 4 & 5. Reception need to know phase 1, 2, 3, & 4.
- Practice handwriting by making lists, writing stories, labels, instructions. Make sure that they use the correct pencil grip and form letters correctly. Most of us are joining up our writing now.
- Keep a diary of some of the days you really enjoyed.
- Writing numbers
- Practice counting in 2's, 5's and 10's.
- Finding 1 more/less, 10 more/less than a number up to 30.

Have fun solving a maths problem:

The animals stack 10 eggs onto 2 shelves. How many different ways can they do this? For example, 4 on one shelf, 6 on the other.

The Easter Bunny puts some eggs in a pattern: pink, yellow, blue, pink, yellow, blue ... One of the foxes says that the 15th egg will be blue. Is he right? Explain your answer
